I have become comfortably numb

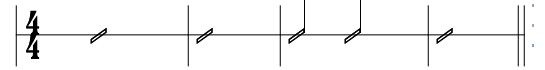

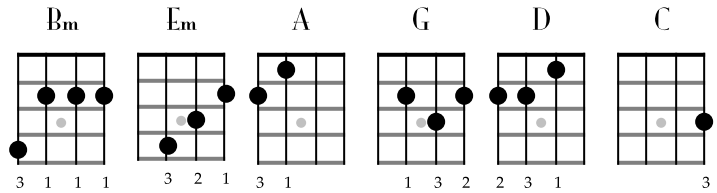

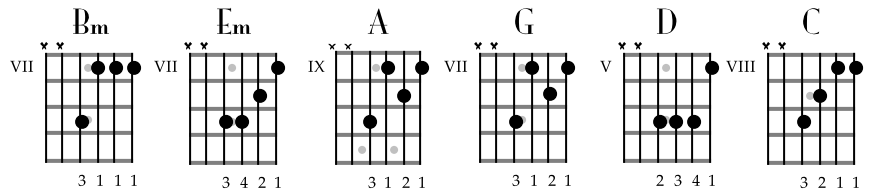
