

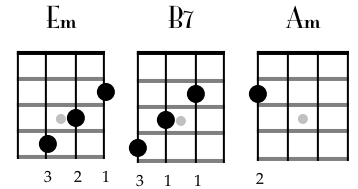

That's nobody's business but the Turks



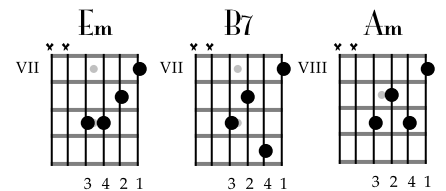
