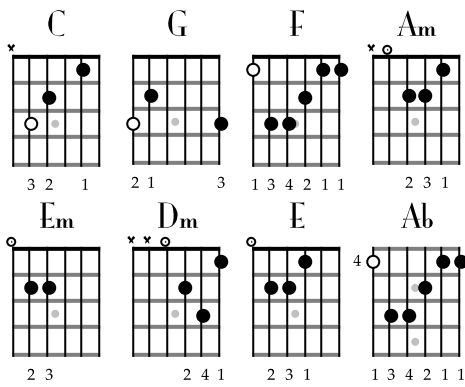

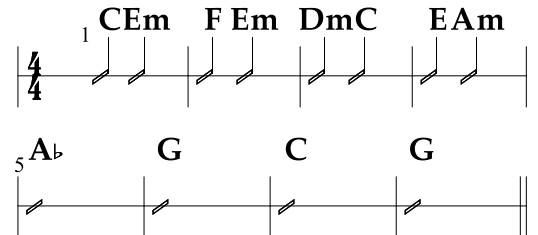

 They're really saying, "I love you."

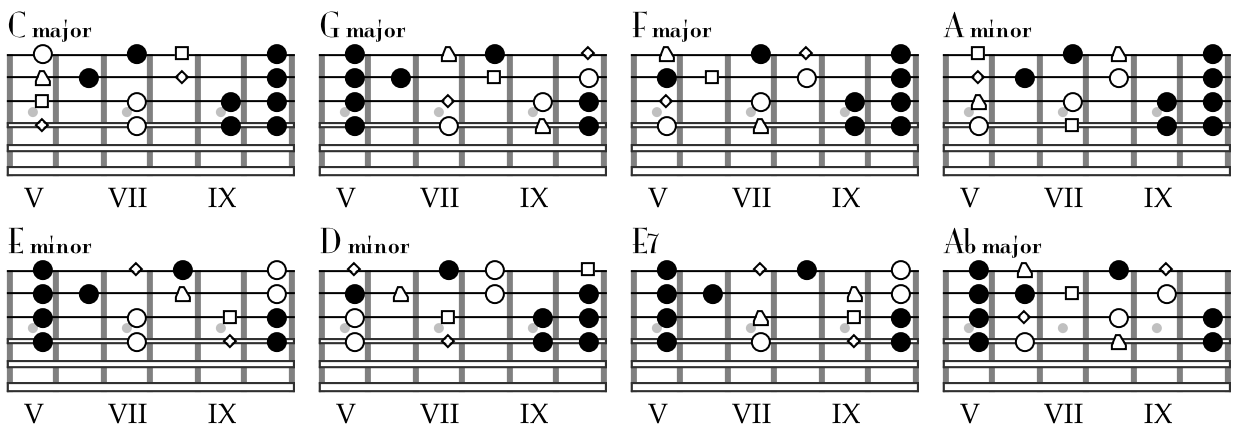
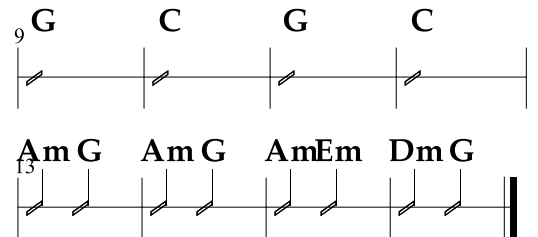
