Am Em


They booked me on a whim and threw me deep in jail


With no bail, sitting silent on a rusty pail


Am Em

Just gazing at the marks on the opposite wall


Remembering the music of my lover's call

til the sheriff pulled me in and he sat me down


CHORUS
