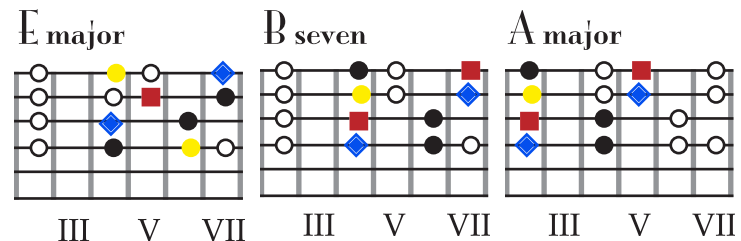
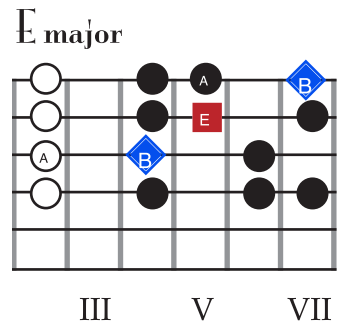
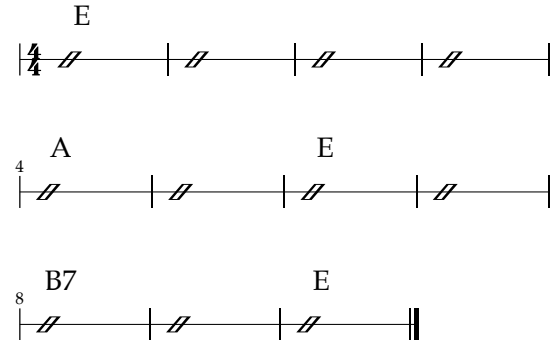
E

When I hear that whistle blowing I hang my head and cry

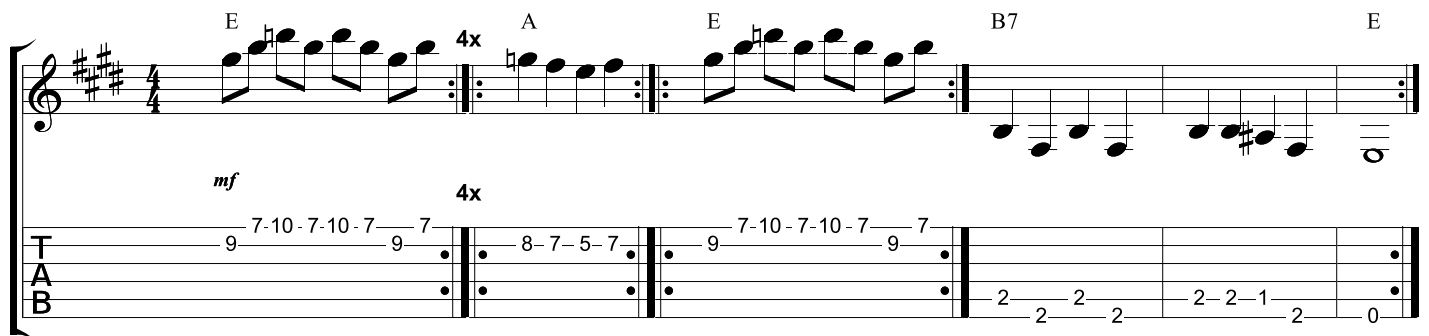
E
