

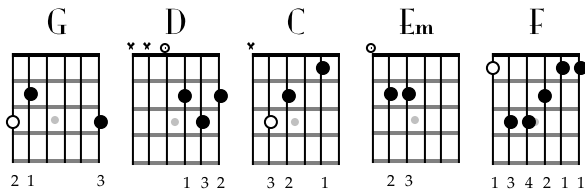

Originally in 'D major'



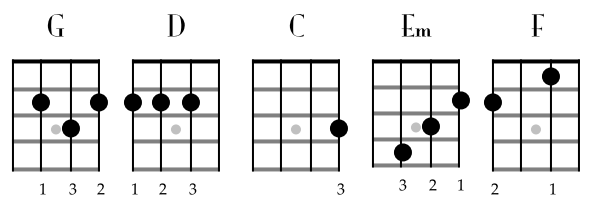
And the sign said long haired, freaky people, need not apply
